2017 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Update

The 2012 Measure L Sales Tax, 2014 Measure J Bond and the 2016 Measure L Bond passed by Orinda residents allocated funding to rehabilitate all Residential roads and drainage systems by 2019. In 2016 alone, 35 Residential roads were reconstructed, improving our Pavement Condition Index (PCI) from "Poor" to "Fair". We are happy to announce that the City's road network PCI will further improve to "Very Good/Excellent" upon project completion set for the end of 2019. *This will be one of the best PCI ratings in the Bay Area!*

The following figures provide historical PCI data and a breakdown of the overall network.

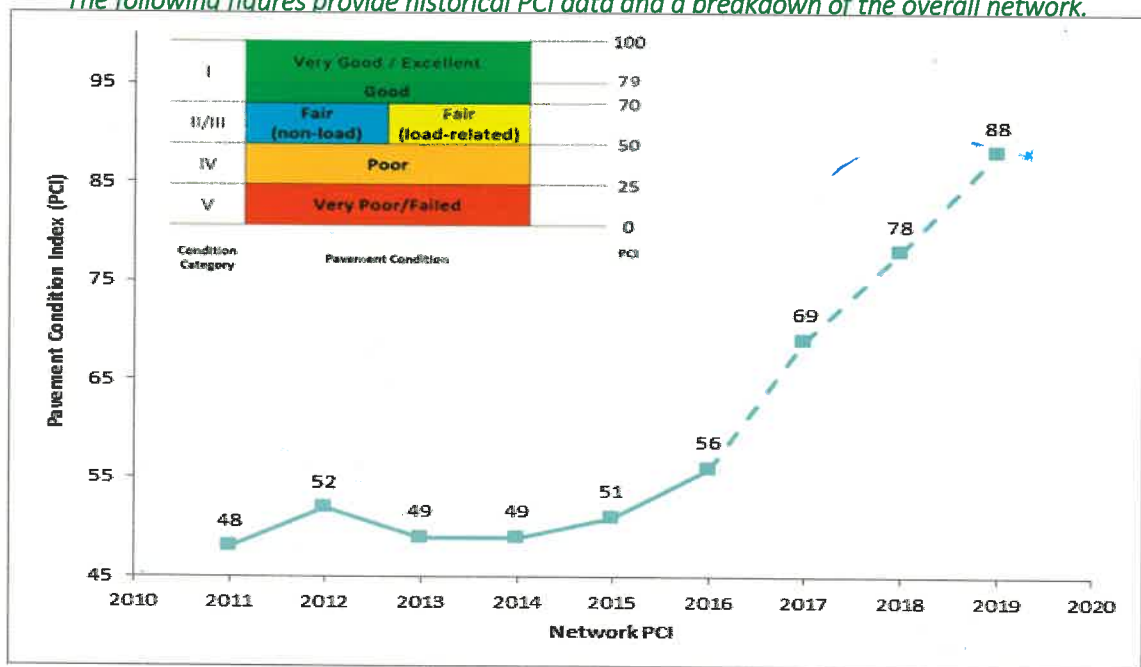
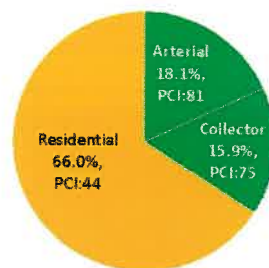
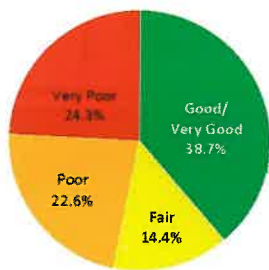


FIGURE 1 - Historical Network PCI from 2011 to 2016
